The Christman Cup

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2019 USGA Championships – see reverse side.)

FORMAT: 18 Hole Individual Stroke Play.

MODEL LOCAL RULES IN EFFECT:

Model Local Rule E-12 (No penalty for a Ball Played from Outside Relief Area when taking back-on-the-line relief)

Model Local Rule G-9 (Permitting Replacing a club significantly damaged other than by abuse)

AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION: All players must carry their own bag or use a push cart. Caddies are NOT permitted.

OUT OF BOUNDS: In addition to the nearest by the inside points at ground level of white stakes, out of bounds is also defined by boundary fence posts and white lines.

**The driving range is out of bounds.*

**The Clubhouse and parking lot are both out of bounds.*

** A ball which crosses a public road defined as out of bounds is out of bounds even though it may lay on another part of the golf course.*

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS: Enclosed white-lined areas are defined as ground under repair, see Rule 16. French drains are deemed to be ground under repair.

**Flowerbeds and turf nurseries are ground under repair.*

PENALTY AREAS: Artificial walls and pilings located in hazards are integral parts of golf course.

** Dropping Zone for Lateral Penalty area on Holes #8 and #10- If a ball is in or it is known or virtually certain that a ball that has not been found last crossed the margin of a Lateral Penalty area (red stakes and lines), the player may: 1) proceed under Rule 17.1d or 2) as an additional option, drop a ball, under penalty of one stroke, in the dropping zone labeled DZ.*

FLAGSTICKS: Flagsticks can remain in the hole or be removed at the players option. The player is NOT required to play with the flagstick in the hole.

BUNKERS: In accordance with GAP's COVID-19 Policies; Bunkers will be treated as following: Players will be allowed to mark, lift, clean and place within the margin of any bunker to a distance no greater than 1 Club Length. The ball must remain within the margin of the bunker. Players are asked to smooth the sand with their feet upon leaving the bunker.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:

1. include, but are not limited to, the maintenance building and associated parking lot, artificially surfaced roads and paths whether paved or surfaced with gravel.
2. Curbing, walls, steps, drains and permanent structures immediately adjacent to, or abutting, artificially surfaced paths are a part of the same obstruction.
3. The split rail fence behind #7 green is an obstruction not a boundary fence.

TIES: All ties to be broken by using the USGA-recommended scorecard tiebreaking method.

PACE OF PLAY COMMITTEE: Chris Roselle, Kirby Martin, Jules Quinones. Maximum Pace has been set at 3 hours and 55 minutes. The 2 Checkpoint Pace of Play Policy is in effect.
