NOTICE TO COMPETITORS

(This information supplements the Championship entry and the Local Rules and Terms of Competition for 2020 GAP Championships – see reverse side.)

FORMAT: 18-Hole greensome (Selective Drive, Alternate Shot). Gross and net in both Divisions. **Penalty shots do not affect the order of play. If a ball is to be dropped, either player may drop the ball.*

TEES: Junior Flight will play from the GAP Black Tee Markers. Junior-Junior Flight will play from the GAP Yellow Tee Markers. **Both players must play the same tee markers.*

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS:

include, but are not limited to artificially surfaced roads and paths whether paved or surfaced with gravel or wood chips.

1. Curbing, walls, steps, drains and permanent structures immediately adjacent to, or abutting, artificially surfaced paths are a part of the same obstruction.
2. As an additional option for relief from the cart path/clubhouse behind #18 green, players may proceed to the drop zone on the left side of the green.

OUT OF BOUNDS: In addition to the nearest inside points at ground level of white stakes, out of bounds is also defined by boundary fences and the course side edge of white lines on some of the public roadways.

**A ball coming to rest on or beyond a public road is out of bounds, even if it comes to rest on another part of the course that is in bounds for other holes.*

***The Driving range, short game area and practice putting green are parts of the golf course in which players may practice on.*

PENALTY AREAS: Artificial walls and pilings located in penalty areas are integral parts of golf course.

ABNORMAL COURSE CONDITIONS: Enclosed white-lined areas are defined as ground under repair, see Rule 16. French drains are deemed to be ground under repair.

FLAGSTICKS: Flagsticks **must** remain in the hole for the duration of the round. Players are asked not to touch the flagstick.

BUNKERS: In accordance with GAP's COVID-19 Policies; Bunkers will be treated as following; Players will be allowed to mark, lift, clean and place within the margin of the Bunker to a distance no greater than 1 club length. The ball must remain within the margin of the bunker. Players are asked to smoothen the sand with their feet upon exiting the bunker.

SCORECARDS: Players are asked to verbally verify their scorecard following their round in the GAP Scoring Area.

TIES: Ties for low gross in both age groups will be named co-champions. All other ties to be broken using the USGA recommended scorecard tiebreaking method. Prizes for 1st and 2nd gross and net in both the Junior and Junior-Junior Flights.

PACE OF PLAY: When play is in groups of **four**, using the selective drive/alternate shot format, each group will be expected to complete 18 holes in not more than a **4 hour**
