## Women's Spring Scramble

Hosted by Lehigh Country Club

### NOTICE TO COMPETITORS



(The USGA & R&A Rules of Golf will govern all play. Including information on the Championship entry form, Interpretations found in the Official Guide, 2020 GAP Terms of Competition in addition to the Local Rules listed below. Any Local Rules listed on the Lehigh CC scorecard are not considered in effect unless listed below)

**FORMAT:** Four Woman Net Scramble. Teams will be divided into 3 different flights by total team handicap.

**TEES:** GAP Yellow Tee Markers

**AUTOMOTIVE TRANSPORTATION:** All players must take a cart for this event.

**PREFERRED LIES:** When a player's ball lies in a part of the general area, the player may take free relief once by placing the original ball or another ball in and playing it from this relief area:

- **Reference Point:** Spot of the original ball
- **Size of Relief Area Measured from Reference Point:** *One club-length* from the reference point but with these limits:
- **Limits on Location of Relief Area:** Must not be nearer the hole than the reference point and must be in the general area

In proceeding under this Local Rule, the player must choose a spot to place the ball and use the procedures for replacing a ball under Rules 14.2b (2) and 14.2e. **The General Area is the area of the course that covers all of the course except for the other four defined areas: (1) the teeing area the player must play from in starting the hole he or she is playing, (2) all penalty areas, (3) all bunkers, and (4) the putting green of the hole the player is playing.**

**SCORING AREA:** Teams will submit their scorecard via the Golf Genius Mobile App. One member of the team will be responsible for verifying the 18-hole total upon completion of the round in the scoring area.

**OUT OF BOUNDS:** Defined by the line between the course-side points, at ground level, of green stakes with white tops along with all boundary fences. See Rule 18.

**\*The driving range and short game area are out of bounds.**

**\*\*A ball which crosses a public road, defined as out of bounds, is still out of bounds even if it lies on another part of the course.**

**GROUND UNDER REPAIR:** Enclosed white-lined areas defined as ground under repair. See Rule 16. French drains are deemed to be ground under repair.

**PENALTY AREAS:** Artificial walls and pilings located in penalty areas are integral objects.

**OBSTRUCTIONS:** Paved and stone cart paths are immovable obstructions and relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1a. Wood chipped and GUR areas leading into cart paths will have the same status as the path, that of obstructions.

**BUNKERS:** In accordance with GAP's COVID-19 Policies; Bunkers will be treated as following: Players will be allowed to mark, lift, clean and place within the margin of any bunker to a distance no greater than 1 Club Length. The ball must remain within the margin of the bunker. Players are asked to smooth the sand with their feet upon leaving the bunker.

**FLAGSTICKS:** Flagsticks may either remain in the hole or be taken out at the players discretion.

**PACE OF PLAY:** The Shotgun Start Pace of Play Policy is in effect. Each group is expected to complete their round in no more than **4 hours and 8 minutes**.

**PRIZES:** Due to the smaller field size prizes will be awarded to 1st place net in each of the 2 flights.

**TIES:** All ties will be broken via the USGA recommended scorecard tiebreak method.
